NEW ISSUE SERVICE MEMBERSHIP AND CONDITIONS

PRICES New Issue items, wherever possible, will be supplied at either our list price, or wherever possible at preferential prices.

FIRST REFUSAL ON LIMITED AVAILABILITY Without doubt this is the major advantage of a new issues service. Whenever items are in short supply or scarce new issue clients will be given first refusal. We reserve the right to use our discretion when distributing limited items. We may take into consideration promptness of payment, credit limit and if similar stamps have been retained in the past. Although we cannot guarantee to supply every item required, every effort will be made to do so.

CONFIRMATION We will confirm our acceptance of your new issue requirements in writing. We reserve the right to decline any request for new issues without giving any reason.

SENDINGS New issues will be sent out every 3/4 months.

CONDITION OF ITEMS SUPPLIED Items will be supplied, whenever possible, in unmounted mint with good perfs. Please note we will not supply any used material or first day covers.

RETURNS Items supplied in accordance with requirements and which are £25 or under **ARE NOT RETURNABLE** unless for reasons of quality or misdescription. Any returns must be made within 14 days (U.K.), 28 days (overseas), and must be packed using stiffener supplied and sent registered post. Items over £25 are automatically sent "on approval".

PAYMENT Payment in full, unless otherwise agreed by us, within 14 days. Payment can be made by any of the methods shown on the application form.

PAYMENT BY OVERSEAS CLIENTS Please note that cheques drawn on overseas banks are subject to high collection charges (approx. £10) and these charges are beyond our control. To avoid you having to pay these charges we recommend payment be made by one of the following methods.
